South Africa - Kruger National Park

Botswana - Chobe National Park



Chobe National Park is known for its large elephant herds and diverse wildlife, with opportunities for river safaris along the Chobe River and game drives in the Savuti Marsh and Linyanti regions.

Kenya - Masai Mara Reserve



The Masai Mara is famous for the annual wildebeest migration, one of the world's most spectacular wildlife events. Visitors can witness vast herds of wildebeest, zebra, and other ungulates crossing the Mara River, along with predators such as lions and cheetahs.

Namibia - Etosha National Park
